MICRO BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

To qualify, the business must:

- ❖ be located in the Chandler area, including home-based businesses
- ❖ be a Chandler Chamber member
- ❖ employ 5 or fewer employees
- ❖ be in sound financial position
- ❖ contribute to growth of local economy
- ❖ have been in business in the Chandler area for at least 2 years
- ❖ offer unique, innovative, high quality service or products
- ❖ demonstrate a pattern of community support/involvement

SMALL BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

To qualify, the business must:

- ❖ be located in the Chandler area
- ❖ be a Chandler Chamber Member
- ❖ employ less than 50 employees
- ❖ be in a sound financial position
- ❖ have been in business in the Chandler area for at least 2 years
- ❖ contribute to the growth of the local economy
- ❖ offer high quality service
- ❖ exhibit innovation in its field
- ❖ demonstrate a pattern of community support/involvement

BUSINESS OF THE YEAR

To qualify, the business must:

- ❖ be located in the Chandler area
- ❖ be a Chandler Chamber Member
- ❖ employ 50 or more employees
- ❖ be in a sound financial position
- ❖ have been in business in the Chandler area for at least 2 years
- ❖ contribute to the growth of the local economy
- ❖ exhibit innovation in its field
- ❖ demonstrate a pattern of community support/involvement

CHAMBER CUP – Nominations may be submitted by any member of the Chandler Chamber of Commerce. The Chandler Chamber of Commerce awards the Chamber Cup to a member to show appreciation for outstanding effort and support on behalf of the organization.

Nominee must:

- ❖ have been actively involved in the Chamber a minimum of two years and produced a significant difference in the welfare of the Chamber
- ❖ be a strong supporter of the organization and its goals
- ❖ demonstrate the following leadership skills:
 - follow through and responsibility for activities and projects
 - work effectively with other participants
 - encourage the participation of others
 - solves problems and exhibit innovative thinking

COMMUNITY CUP - The Chandler Chamber of Commerce awards the Community Cup to an organization, individual or couple to show appreciation for outstanding volunteerism.

Nominee must:

- ❖ live in the Chandler area
- ❖ have been actively involved in the community for a long period of time (although many community leaders generously lend their name to assist various activities, the Chandler Cup requires that the recipient be actively involved in these activities)
- ❖ have created a significant difference in the quality of life in Chandler and exhibit a high degree of willingness to help others

JAMES R. SNEDIGAR PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD - The James R. Snedigar Award recognizes excellence beyond the call of duty.

Nominee must:

- ❖ exhibit the character and standards that reflect those of the award namesake, Officer James R. Snedigar
- ❖ works in the public sector and made a significant difference in the quality of life of an individual, a group, or the citizens of Chandler
- ❖ have been actively involved in the community for a long period of time, or has demonstrated exceptional concern for the well-being and/or safety of others
