### The Program

Chandler Leadership Institute is a unique on-site, hands-on training program featuring presentations, tours, discussions and exposure to critical issues facing Chandler in areas such as:

**Orientation...**will be held in January.

**Issue Days...**are held the third Friday of each month, 7:45 a.m. - 3:00 p.m., January through October.

**Attendance Points...**are earned for participation in the program. In order to graduate, participants are limited to no more than two absences.

**Application...**To be eligible for Chandler Leadership, an applicant must live or do business in Chandler. Participants will be chosen through a selection process.

**Tuition...**The tuition fee for Chandler Leadership Institute is non-refundable \$500. This covers study materials, meals, registration, graduation, and expenses related to class participation.

**Alumni...**Chandler Leadership graduates become members of the Steering Committee that plans the Issue Days for the incoming class.
